New Kitchen Director

In 2014, Regina Foster began working at Grand Central Station as a volunteer, and said, "she deeply enjoyed making and providing meals for people who needed it most". On June 24th Regina was hired as the Kitchen Director following Ben Merrill's retirement. Regina brings over 30 years' experience in the business and culinary world and an Associate's degree in Culinary Arts from our very own Grayson College. We are so blessed to have her join our Grand Central Station's family.





Children's Express is currently serving 600 children weekly for our weekend back pack program through 6 schools.

A small group began meeting in the Spring of 2012 to study what could be done to feed our hungry children. After months of evaluating numerous programs, it was decided to organize a weekly summer distribution program and as needed when school was not in session. It was also determined that the program start small and expand as resources became available. Jefferson Elementary was our pilot school. By the summer of 2015, all eight elementary schools were part of the program. In the Fall of 2015, feedback from the teachers indicated that many children were returning on Monday not having had anything to eat over the weekend. This prompted us to begin our weekend program. In February of 2016, the weekend lunch program began serving 120 students at two elementary schools. At the end of the 2018-2019 school year, we were distributing 602 bags on a weekly basis to six of the elementary schools for a total of 19,209 for the year. We receive money from local organizations, private donors and grants; along with the help of many dedicated volunteers, we are able to feed our children in need.
